Information for Dog Owners

We are delighted to welcome your dog(s) and hope that you have an enjoyable stay together. The Yorkshire Dales is a very dog friendly place and there are several recommendations in our guide book for dog-friendly cafes, pubs and restaurants.

We know that our furry friends do not always read the rules but we do ask the following:

- There is **no garden area** at Lightfoot House. Dogs can be exercised and toileted on the nearby village green which can be accessed via the right of way access at the rear of the property and where the nearest dog waste bin is located.
- Dog(s) are not to be left unattended in the cottage. We ask this as unfamiliar surroundings can cause anxiety and stress which can lead to barking/howling and unacceptable noise for our neighbours.
- Please do not allow dog(s) on the beds and furniture.
- We do have a dog bed available for use during your stay, spare bowls and supply of spare doggy bags. If you use a crate to house your dog(s) we have available space in the kitchen under the staircase.
- When exercising your dog(s) **please keep them on a lead**. There are working farms in and around Redmire and livestock in the surrounding fields. This is especially important during lambing season (Mid March onwards) as any stress to pregnant ewes can cause miscarriage.
